Guest Speaker: Stephen McCombie, NAB

Stephen McCombie is the Senior Manager of nabCERT at the National Australia Bank. nabCERT's responsibilities include cybercrime response, computer forensics, security research and strategic IT threat intelligence.

Stephen presentation will focus on:

- Introduction to the Cybercrime Research Lab at Macquarie University
- How the hacking environment changed
- How financial industry phishing changed things
- Who are these people
- What can we expect in the future

Stephen previously served 14 years in the NSW Police Force in general duties, as an investigator and as a detective. Whilst at the Fraud Squad he helped establish their Computer Crime Unit.

Since joining the private sector in 1998 he has worked with Qantas Airways' Security & Investigation Services, with Westpac Bank in IT Security and as Manager of IBM's CERT team in Australia.

Stephen is currently a PhD candidate at Macquarie University's School of Computing doing research into transnational and organised cybercrime and is the Industry Director of Macquarie University's Cybercrime Research Lab. He has also published a number of papers on cybercrime, computer forensics and incident response.
